

GTP Heidelberg special automatic platen 13³/₈ x 18¹/₈" (34 x 46 cm) for hot stamping with roll foils

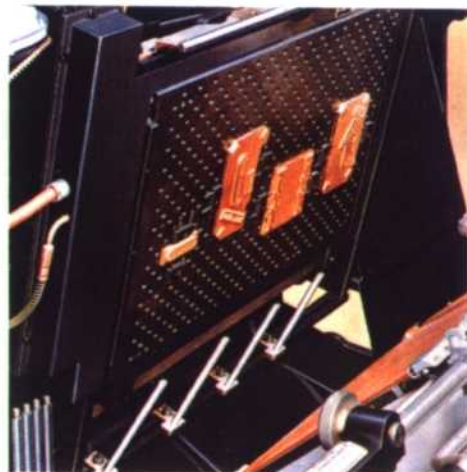
All models are supplied with electronic temperature control.

Width of foil roll of TP I: up to 4" (10 cm), with diameter up to 1³/₄" (4.5 cm).

Width of foil roll of TP II: up to 6" (15 cm), with diameter up to 1³/₄" (4.5 cm), or up to 3" (7.6 cm), with diameter up to 5" (12.5 cm).

The basic T model can be subsequently equipped, commencing with a specific serial number, with special accessories 01.560.000 or 01.562.000 and be so converted into models TP I and TP II, respectively. The TP models can also be used for normal printing, without the need to remove the complete special accessories. They are the most versatile Heidelberg platens on the market (see page 12, column TP).

The GTP, however, is clearly a speciality press mainly intended for die-cutting, foil stamping, blind embossing and similar jobs. Its maximum foil pull is 11 ¹³/₁₆" (300 mm), with a maximum foil width of 4 rolls of 4" (10 cm) each*, of a diameter of 5" (12.5 cm) or – with a special accessory – one roll up to 16¹/₂" (42 cm) wide, having a diameter of 2¹/₂" (6.5 cm). A number of

additional special accessories provides more applications (see page 10).

*or even up to 4¹/₂" (11.5 cm), if lay guides are not used.
