





It's easy to operate, with up to 42 inches of limitless perf and score lines, depending on model size. Heavy-duty construction and superior engineering make the 990 practically indestructible. It never wears out and requires virtually no maintenance to keep it going strong, year after year.

Very simply, it's the industry's most popular and affordable perforating, scoring and slitting machine. It's a Rollem. And when you start with the best, you can finish like a Champion.

Scoring is governed using the depth control lever. The depth of your score is precisely controlled by raising or lowering the arm.



How to Recognize a Champion

TRY LIFTING IT

The Champion 990 is constructed of heavyduty Sheffield steel. No light-weight aluminium or plastic.

Its base is a solid mold of cast iron: not pieces of metal put together with screws or rivets. This makes the Champion 990 extremely sturdy and stable, especially under high-speed operation. It doesn't vibrate or bounce which can cause alignment problems and excess wear on moving parts.

PERFECT FOR THE JOB

The Champion 990 is engineered to finish the job right!

You can select from 13 interchangeable perforating blades as well as five separate scoring heads. And there are five different models, based on sheet size: 18", 24", 30", 36" or 42".

INSTANT ADJUSTMENTS

A side-to-side micrometer aligns your stock to the cutting head. Makes critical adjustments with instant accuracy.

The two-piece side guide is easily aligned to compensate for registration and paper stock imperfections. The 990 can salvage an off-register job – saving hundreds, even thousands of pounds on reprints.

A control lever mounted on the side of the 990 is used for obtaining precise scoring depth. Simply lift or lower the depth control lever to add or release pressure without losing control of the stock as it passes through.

CONTINUOUS OPERATION

The Champion's auto-fan-feed is the most efficient and accurate ever conceived. It automatically fans the paper by feeding from the bottom which allows continuous operation.

The entire feed roller revolves on the 990, gripping a larger area on the sheet and eliminating side-to-side movement of the stock. A calibrator positioned directly above the feed roller acts as a gate so that only one sheet at a time passes through the heads.

ANYTHING GOES

The Champion will perf, score and slit any type stock: from 45gsm stock to 750 micron board. Even open-end NCR sets don't pose a problem for the 990.

HERE'S THE BIG DIFFERENCE

Around each head is a rubber ring which grips and controls the sheet. This patented head design ensures a flawless perforation, score or slit: no crimping, tail-whip or run-off.

As the feed roller pulls the stock up, a "smoother bar" directly above pushes it back down toward the heads. The sheet forms a gentle "S" shape that keeps it from buckling when the incision is made.

The micrometer on the paper guides makes adjustments fast and simple. Use it to split a line with amazing precision.

ANYONE CAN FINISH WITH A CHAMPION

You don't need a pressman to operate the 990. It's simple to use; set-up for most jobs takes only minutes. A variable speed drive lets you feed up to 18,000 sheets per hour.

And it runs forever.


